



## **HEALTHCERTIFICATE for Live Birds FROM BELGIUM TO CANADA**

- 1.the birds originate from a country designated to be free of Newcastle disease.**
  
- 2.the birds being exported are not vaccinated against Avian Influenza(H5,H7)**
  
- 3.the birds were inspected by an official veterinarian and showed no clinical signs of HPNAI within 24 hours of shipment.**
  
- 4.the birds were kept in an HPNAI free country , zone or compartment since they were hatched or for the past 21 days**
  
- 5.the country has an official surveillance plan for Notifiable Avian Influenza (NAI) in place that has been carried out in the establishment within the past 21 days.**
  
- 6.the birds have been continually resident in the country of origin for a minimum of sixty(60) days , since birth or hatching immediately preceding export .**
  
- 7.the flock has been examined and found free from evidence of clinical disease within thirty(30) days prior to the time of export.**
  
- 8.the birds have been found healthy and free from any clinical evidence of infectious disease and as far as can be determined, exposure thereto.**
  
- 9.the birds are fit to be transported without undue suffering by reason of infirmity, illness,injury,fatigue or other cuase during the expected journey**
  
- 10.the birds are shipped in new clean containers or cages**
  
- 11.the birds are examined on the date of undersigment.**
