# Note

1. The identification number stated in the certificate should be identical with that which can be found on the animal. When electronic identification is used, the type of microchip and the name of the manufacturer should be specified.
2. Only inactivated virus vaccines are authorized for international movement of dogs and cats.
3. In the case of a primary vaccination, the animal should have been vaccinated not more than 1 year prior to its introduction into the importing country.
4. The animal should have been subjected not less than 3 months and not more than 24 months prior to its introduction into the importing, to a neutralizing antibody titration test. It should be carried out by an Official diagnostic laboratory serum should contain at least 0.5 International Units (IU) /ml.
5. The clinical examination referred to in Part B of the certificate must be carried out within 48 hours of shipment.

The Competent Authority of the importing country may require the placing of animals which do not comply with any of the above-mentioned condition in a quarantine station located on its territory the conditions of stay in quarantine are laid down by the legislation of the importing country.

6. If the veterinarian whose name and signature appear on the certificate in not an official veterinarian, his signature must be authenticated in the relevant column by the signature and stamp of an Official Veterinarian, The expression 'Official Veterinarian' means a civil service veterinarian or a specially appointed veterinarian, as authorised by the Veterinary Authority of the country.
7. If so required, the certificate should be written in the language of the importing country. In such circumstances, it should also be written in a language understood by the certifying veterinarian.
