II. Sanitary Information:

1. The birds came from the breeding center, which approved and regularly inspected by the Veterinary Authority, and they showed no clinical signs of infectious or contagious diseases on the day of shipment.
2. The exporting country is free from Notifiable Avian Influenza (NAI) as per the OIE Terrestrial Code.
3. The birds were kept in isolation approved by the Veterinary Services since they were hatched or for at least 21 days prior to shipment and showed no clinical signs of infectious diseases including NAI during the isolation period.
4. The birds (statistically valid samples) were subjected to diagnostic test with negative results prescribed by the OIE Manual for the following diseases:

- a. Notifiable avian influenza within 14 days prior to shipment.
- b. Newcastle Disease (ND) virus within 14 days prior to shipment.
- c. Establishment free or agent identification for West Nile Fever at least 3 days after the commencement of the residence.

5. The birds came from establishment free from **Infectious Bursal Disease, Avian mycoplasmosis, Avian chlamydiosis, Fowl typhoid, Pullorum disease, Infectious Bronchitis, Infectious laryngotracheitis, Avian tuberculosis and Newcastle diseases;**

6. A birds are transported in new containers and birds of different species are not kept in the same cages.

III. Validity of the International Veterinary Certificate

The certificate is valid for two days from the date of loading.
